PARKING

- Getting to Centennial Park: Free buses will operate to the Moore Park bus interchange from Chalmers St, Central Station from 2.30pm
- Going home: Free buses to Central Station will operate from Centennial Park after the show.
- Limited parking will be available in the car parks at Driver Ave Moore Park and the Entertainment Quarter.
- NO PARKING in Centennial Park for this event.

For your safety and comfort please note the following:

- This is a licensed all-age event. Please provide photo ID if you wish to drink.
- Alcohol sales are subject to Responsible Service of Alcohol and Harm Minimisation Practices.
- We are prohibited by law from serving liquor to intoxicated persons.
- Patrons are allowed to bring sealed plastic bottles of water onto the site. There will be free water stations for refilling.
- All patrons must have a valid ticket or other authorisation to enter the venue.
- Children under 5 years of age are not permitted.
- Eftpos facilities are available for cash withdrawal.
- Security procedures are in effect and you may be requested to submit to a search of your person and/or property. Failure to comply will mean you will be prevented from entering the site.
- Appropriate standards of behavior are expected and persons deemed to be behaving in a manner that is dangerous or unacceptable to management will be refused admission and/or removed from the premises.
- Disruptive or offensive behavior will result in service being denied and removal of such offenders from the licensed premises.
- Activities such as 'stage diving' and 'moshing' are strictly prohibited.
- Those attempting to gain entry to the site by way of fence jumping will be prosecuted with trespass. Substantial fines will apply.

Patrons are not permitted to bring the following items in to the venue:

- Alcoholic refreshments
- Picnic rugs or similar ground covering materials
- No Picnic Hampers or Commercial Food
- Illicit drugs
- Glass, cans or metal drink bottles
- Skateboards, scooters, roller blades or bicycles
- Umbrellas, strollers, picnic blankets or baskets, chairs or eskys
- Weapons, packages or fireworks
- Studded clothing and accessories
- Video taping equipment and professional cameras
- Animals (apart from authorised guide/companion dogs)
- And any other items deemed by management to be dangerous or capable of causing a public nuisance.
